September Sustainable Breakfast Series

Sustainable Breakfast Series: Carbon Sequestration

At our September Sustainable Breakfast Series, we learned about the science behind carbon sequestration and local projects happening here in Dane County. We explored how soil organic carbon acts as a natural climate solution by capturing and storing carbon, improving soil health, and reducing carbon emissions. Speakers explained how the Dane County Land and Resources Department has a program to purchase and convert agricultural land into perennial farming or prairie restoration. Also, they are conducting long-term soil monitoring that will help meet county-wide climate goals.

Attendees left with an understanding of the science of capturing and storing carbon, how our local sequestration projects are contributing to our climate goals, and that what is beneath our feet has the power to reduce climate change.

Efficiency Navigator

Efficiency Navigator Update

Sustain Dane and partners are hard at work with the Efficiency Navigator program, supporting small to medium-sized affordable apartment housing to become more efficient, affordable, and resilient.

We recently completed work on a 4-unit building built in 1983 in Fitchburg's Jamestown Neighborhood. Improvements included air sealing, insulation, bath fan replacement & venting, kitchen exhaust duct air sealing & insulation, and new Energy Star refrigerators. A tenant stated that their monthly utility bills are \$10-20 less than at this same time last year.

The efficiency upgrades performed will have an estimated \$410 in annual utility cost savings, annual CO2 emissions savings of 1,430 kg, which is the equivalent of 3,642 vehicle miles travel per year. Sun Prairie Composting

Sun Prairie Composting Pilot

Sustain Dane, in partnership with the City of Sun Prairie, Green Box Compost, and Sun Prairie School District, kicked off a school composting pilot program in September. Elementary students at Token Springs and Royal Oaks are now composting in their own cafeteria. The West High School kitchen production staff will also be diverting their food scraps to compost. We are excited to announce that all three schools started kick-off with students and staff on the first day of school, September 2nd.

In the first week, 365 pounds of food scraps were diverted from the landfill to Green Box Composting. The food scraps are composted into fertile compost that will be diverted to local agriculture and gardens.
